GENERAL INFORMATION

Acceptance and participation in our camping program is without regard to race, color or national origin. Our program is ecumenical. Registration is limited and on a first-come, first-served basis. REGISTER EARLY!

How to Register:

- Each camp's registration period ends 2 weeks before the camp opens. However, late registrations will be accepted until the camp is filled.
- You may copy this form. Registration forms are also available at churches, at <u>www.dmpresbytery.org</u> and from the Camp Registrar. There is a 25% deposit required with each registration. The deposit fee is not refundable and will be applied to the event fee.
- 3. Send completed form and deposit to:

- 4. Make checks payable to: Presbytery of Des Moines.
- Cancellations and refunds: (1) a full refund will be made if the registration is canceled by us, but (2), if the registration is canceled by you; the deposit is nonrefundable.
- Payment of balance is expected 2 weeks before the event. If part of the balance will be paid by your local church, please place that information on the registration form and inform the Camp Registrar at the time of registration.
- Please be sure to include the event number on your registration form.

Insurance and Health Forms:

A completed *Health Form* is required of all campers and is sent upon receipt of the registration form. It MUST be signed by the parent and/or guardian, brought to camp and turned in at the time of registration. Accident insurance covers registrants at all of the sites.

Confirmation Letter:

Each camper, upon acceptance, will receive a letter from the Camp Registrar telling them telephone numbers where they can be reached in the event of an emergency and directions to the camp.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Financial assistance is available. However, available funding is limited and does require financial need. You should first contact your local church, because many churches will provide full or partial scholarships even if financial need doesn't exist. REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

Instructions:

- A. Use an official registration form. Feel free to reproduce.
- B. Fill out registration form completely.
 - 1. List choices by event number.
 - Have parents and pastor/clerk of session sign. Your pastor can also provide you with your church # code. Ask about your church supporting a portion of the fee—many do.
- C. Send completed form and deposit to: Camp Registrar

Payment of Balance:

- Payment-in-full at time of registration makes everyone's bookkeeping easier and reduces possibilities of confusion.
- 2. Payment of balance due in full, 2 weeks prior to event.

Cancellations and Refunds:

- Cancellation by us-full refund. If the event you register for is full or is cancelled, every effort will be made to help you transfer to another event. If a transfer cannot be made, you will receive a full refund.
- Cancelled by you—refund all but deposit. Deposits are used by site and Event Director in making preparations for registered campers.
